A MESSAGE FROM THE MASTER



My Brethren:

Let us for a moment dwell in retrospect. When any Master enters his year, his first concern should be his program for the year. I refer to the trip to our Children's Home. This trip was not supported as well as it should have been. The other event was the blood donors day held at Las Palmas on May 9th. This program was set up to accommodate all the lodges in this area and to replenish our Masonic blood supply. A short accounting will indicate why this was a disappointment. There was a total of 32 donors from all the lodges, 16 from Las Palmas, 16 from all the other lodges. A total of 9 donors were rejected for various reasons. In short, there was a net total of 23 pints, of which 10 pints were credited to Las Palmas. This, my brethern, should not be construed as a reprimand, but as a reminder that should the occasion arise, as Masons we are our brother's keeper.

If any of you would care to rectify an oversight or a conflict of hours, you can do so by calling the Blood Bank at 224-2900 for an appointment at your convenience. This will be 15 minutes well spent and Las Palmas will receive credit for the donation.
