



So how many Masons actually found the "Masonic cipher text" on the back of Dan Brown's "The Lost Symbol?" How many Masons actually knew there was such a "Masonic" cipher? As much as we all love a good mystery, puzzles can be just as much fun. Try "Kryptos" or "The Phaistos Disk" for example. One of the first puzzles ever made is an Egyptian papyrus over 3,600 years old and introduces 85 problems for "grasping the meaning of things and knowing"

everything that is." The concept of laying a "Cornerstone" actually comes from the Old Testament, Psalms 118:22. The ancient clues of initiation and rites of passage begin to lead us toward

enlightenment...

One of the very first writers was Ptahhotep, an ancient Egyptian official during the late 25<sup>th</sup> century B.C. "The Instruction of Ptahhotep" is an early piece of Egyptian "wisdom literature" meant to instruct young men in appropriate behavior.
