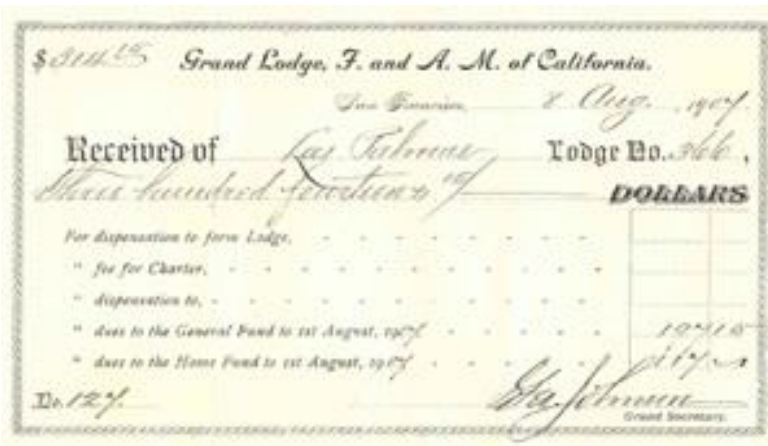


On Saturday, September 27, 1980 at 8 p.m. we had a dinner party and program to celebrate the 75th year of Las Palmas Lodge.
