

## THE SECRETARY'S CORNER

Several errors were made by the printers in compiling our 1972 Membership Roster. Each of our membership have received a notice from the "printers" concerning this, requesting that you check your roster and if found in error; return it to them so that they may forward to you a correct and complete "Roster". This is important; therefore if you have not already checked this, do so now.



I am pleased to report to you that our membership contributions to the Masonic Homes Endowment Fund as of March 31, 1972 totaled \$2,670.50; as being received from 343 of our members. Our Masonic year for the "Homes Fund" runs from July 1 to June 30 of the following year.

Our total contributions for the year 7-1-70 to 6-30-71, totaled \$2,809.65 received from 380 of our membership. We still have April, May and June of this year to go and I am hoping and believe that we will exceed the previous year's contributions. Remember in your contributions, they are "Tax deductible" and there could be no greater cause than this; our "Masonic Charity" to our members and their loved ones who are within the "Homes" you have provided for them.

I regret that I must inform 205 of our membership that their dues are in arrears. It is most important to you and your Lodge that your dues are paid up in accordance with our Masonic By-Laws and Grand Lodge rulings.

A member should not be admitted to any Lodge unless he is in possession of a paid up dues receipt. Further, those that are in arrears more than one year, are subject to "Suspension of Membership" unless he can show good cause to me and the Lodge why the dues remain unpaid. 19 of our members owe in addition to their 1972 dues; their 1971 dues also. While it is important for all members to be current, it is vitally important members owing for 1971 and 1972 pay them now without any further delay. In the event illness or hardship prevents payment of dues, please advise me of the fact so I may be governed accordingly.
