
Hollon O. Kinney went to Washington D.C. as part of our Grand Master's project to visit the War Memorial.

Hail, Brethren!



One of my first questions on being raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason was "Okay, so what are we doing for St. John the Baptist's Day?" As you may or may not know, the day in question is June 24th. The "day" is celebrated in France, Canada and most Scandinavian countries.
